

Evian, and the Southern shores of lake Leman

Geographical Location

Located to the north of the region of Haute-Savoie Evian faces Switzerland (the city of Lausanne is just 13 km away across the lake). Set amidst the foothills of the Chablais region, the town is built in the shape of an amphitheatre on the edge of Lake Leman between 372 m altitude of the lake - and 730 m. Evian has 7500 inhabitants, being the main county town of a canton covering 15 districts.

Paris (580 km) - Lyon (190 km) - Annecy (85 km) - Geneva (45 km) - Thonon (9 km) - Swiss border (Valais) 18 km away (5t Gingolph).

A Truly Outstanding Environment between Lake and Mountains

The lake and mountain provide an ideal environment for tourism. Through its policy of attentive care and maintenance of natural areas and the promotion of civic awareness of the highest standard, the town itself contributes greatly to enhancing respect for this quite unique situation. Offering tourism for leisure, good health and business, over the years Evian has become recognised as a resort and venue open all year round.

Historical Overview

Evian is never mentioned in accounts covering the first thousand years of our era. Over the centuries, the town changed its name several times: Aguianum in 1150, Aguiano in 1219, Ayviens in 1420 and finally Evian les Bains in 1864, shortly after the annexation of Savoy by France. It was from the Middle Ages onwards that the village began to expand, firstly with the construction of a château in the 12th century and the granting of franchises. Evian then became a market town, commercial port on the lake and a preferred place of stay of the counts and dukes of Savoy. The first recorded appearance of the coat of arms of the town dates from the 15th century, bearing the Latin motto 'deo et ducis fidelis perpetuo' (Loyalty everlasting to God and the Duke). It was not until the end of the 15th century, with the discovery of the qualities of its mineral water that the town truly began to

Most of the historic buildings protected to date were built between 1870 and 1913, with the fame of the town reaching its peak in the 1930's when it became recognised as an International Spa.

Mineral Water Springs Avenue des Sources

The Cachat spring - formerly known as the Saint Catherine Fountain, is the most famous of the numerous springs found existing in Evian. Built in 1903, at the same time as the pump room standing opposite it, the spring runs continuously all year round and anyone at all is welcome to quench their thirst there. A few metres further along, we also find the spring of the Cordeliers.

La Société des Eaux Minérales d'Evian

Exhibition Hall

Located at 19 rue nationale (pedestrianised street), this building, erected in 1903 in accordance with a design by the architect Jean-Albert Hébrard, is a master-piece of Art Nouveau and was once used to house the thermal pump room. From May to September, it serves as a venue for an exhibition and video screenings showing products available under the Evian brand, including educational games and general information about the water. Speciality shop available for purchase of advertising products and items.

Bottling Factory Tour Industrial Estate - Amphion Plain, 5 km from Evian

Guided tours, including a presentation of the historical background and geological origin of the mineral water, followed by an enlightening discovery of the bottling process in all its stages: manufacture of the bottles, extraction and decanting, packaging and dispatch. Discovering Evian Heritage - Culture and Traditions

Historical Tour of the Town

Departing from the Tourist Office, this tour comprises 14 information stopping points, providing comprehensive details of the history of the main historical buildings, from the Middle Ages through to the Belle Epoque.

This is the commercial high street of the town, featuring some beautiful façades of Italian inspi-


Thermal Pump Room and Springs

Standing in the centre of rue Nationale, this master-piece of Art Nouveau houses the information offices of Eaux Minérales Evian. A short walk around the building will take you to the springs.

La "Villa Lumière" (1885-1896)
Former summer residence of the Lumière family (inventors of the cinema), this magnificent villa with a distinctive classical French style inspired by the Renaissance became the Town Hall in

Free tour of the fover, grand salon and gilded salon between 9am and midday and 2 to 5pm during the week.


Theatre and Casino
The Theatre (1883 - 1885) is a fine example of neo-classical art and was designed by a student of Charles Garnier (in charge of building the Paris Opera House) - Admittance only during the performances season and in particular during the summer theatre festivals from July until September. The Casino, dating back to 1911, was designed by the architect J.A. Hébrard and was built on the site of the château de Blonay, bequeathed to the town in 1877 to allow for the creation of a 'gaming club'.











Medieval church built in the 13th century. Frescos, wooden stalls, statues...

The Funicular Railway, a journey back in time to the beginning of the last century

Departure at the rear of the building of the 'Palais Lumière' (old thermal baths), from the 'station aux sources', Arrival at the 'plateau des Mateirons' (Hôtel Ermitage).

Construction of the railway began in 1907 and it was originally intended to provide transport for people taking the waters at the grand hotels, stopping firstly at the thermal pump room before proceeding on to the thermal baths establishment itself. Services resumed in 2002 following complete modernisation of the carriages, stations, engines and equipment.


Small Boat Outings aboard "La Savoie"

An exact replica of the small traditional lateen sail boats once used on Lake Leman, «La Savoie» is one of the largest reconstructed heritage boats in France. Organised cruises.

Le Palais Lumière

This architectural gem, which served as a spa from 1902 to 1984, has been turned into a Cultural and Convention Centre including an auditorium, 10 meeting rooms, exhibition spaces and a media library.

Lake Léman

Julius Caesar named lacus lemanus in 58 BC when he left Genava to fight the Helvetians. It is often called Lake Geneva, but the official name is actually Lake Léman.

Lake Léman was formed as the Rhône glacier receded around 15,000 ago. Western Europe's biggest lake, it has a surface area of 583 km² and a volume of 89 km³. The Rhône crosses the lake from east to west. Its maximum depth is 309 metres between Evian and Lausanne. The 167-km shoreline is shared by France (53 km) and Switzerland (114 km).

The lake's temperature easily reaches 22 to 25°C in summer and it does not freeze in winter.



Passenger transport across the lake

Every day, the Compagnie Générale de Navigation (C.G.N.) ferries passengers back and forth across the lake between France and Switzerland on some of western Europe's most beautiful paddle-wheel steamboats. The trip between Lausanne and Evian takes 35 minutes. Other French companies offer cruises during the summer season.

The fish of Lake Léman

The most famous and prized species are the char, lake whitefish (whose local name is féra), perch and lake trout, but there are also roaches in abundance, monkfish, pike and even crayfish.





Water gardens

Acquired in 1995 by the lakeside Conservatory, with the support of the Evian and Publier town councils, the Haute-Savoie general council and the Rhône-Alpes Region, the Pré-Curieux is an unique location for the discovery of wetlands.

What "Pré-Curieux" is all about

In 1998, a partnership agreement between the State / the Ramsar* Convention / the lakeside Conservatory and the Town of Evian consecrated the site as a "research unit" and International communication centre on wetlands. Open to the public, the site has also become a branch of the Ramsar Convention and welcomes researchers from all over the World. Located on the lakeside. at the Western entry to Evian, the property includes a charming colonial style house with its 3.5 hectare wooded parkland spreading out from it. A first turn around the house will enable, by following the exhibitions put up by our various partners, a discovery of the function, wealth and fragility of wetlands.

"The water gardens"

The stroll continues in the park, which is organised around the various water based ecosystems. Here, an architectural water garden. This is where the carp live and thrive in pools spread over with water lilies and water buttercups.

Over there, the natural water gardens: a waterfall, a pond, a marsh, wet fields and a delta, sheltering flora and fauna as unusual as they are

Floral decoration,

a tradition

Evian benefits from exceptional natural surroundings, enhanced, since the last century, by a major arboreal heritage. Arranged as a "garden town", Evian offers high quality lawns, planted with trees and shrubs. To this can be added a long floral tradition has raised Evian to rank among the most floral towns in France.

Evian, garden town

The age old reputation of the waters and the surroundings have led to the constitution of many parks. Around the spas, major hotels and miscellaneous private estates, these parks, planted at the beginning of the last century on the town slopes, now blend into the natural land-scape.

Evian's parks are designed as English gardens, with curving alleyways separating the varying shaped and sized lawns, where trees, shrubs and cultivated varieties are laid out in a random design.

One particular case is known in Evian as the "Japanese Garden". This precious miniature, with it numerous dwarf conifers and its varied shrubs is the ideal décor for photographers.



Public gardens made up of small lines of clumps make up the décor along the quayside promenade, with here, the romantic garden, ther, the English garden, and there the gardens of Benicassim and Neckargemünd (named after the Spanish and German towns twinned with Evian).

A town that blooms in all seasons

With four floral seasons per year, Evian can take pride in a constant floral décor that varies with the rhythm of the seasons.

National and local festivals, events of all kinds are excuses for the composition of floral decors.





Shops and services

Although essentially a tourist resort, Evian is also a market town in a canton with some 25,000 inhabitants and is a focal point for lively commercial exchanges throughout the year. All types of shops and services can be found here, with about 220 shops for visitors' convenience. Grouped into associations, the shopkeepers of Evian contribute significantly to promoting local cultural activities: fashion parades, cut-price sales, shop window competitions.

Evian and the Craft Professions

A member of the national association "Villes et Métiers d'Art", Evian is a venue for artists and craftsmen in residence: ceramists, glass cutters and engravers, glass and tapestry artists, painters... Make sure to meet them during your visit.

Weekly Markets

The town quarter surrounding the church comes to life every Tuesday and Friday morning with the highly colourful market offering the finest traditional and exotic flavours of products from Upper Savoy. Discover the local cheeses (Abondance, Reblochon, Tomme, etc.) salted meats and fish traditionally caught in the lake (perch, fera, char, trout).

Shops and town planning

Evian's shopping district has been undergoing sweeping changes for several years. The old post office on Place Ch. de Gaulle was torn down, and will be replaced in spring 2007 by a pedestrian area with stepped seats and a 264-space underground car park. Near the lake, the Pari's section between the theatre and the town hall will be turned into a real estate complex with 34 housing units and two brasseries-restaurants.



The Palais Lumière

This imposing building, which housed Evian's baths from 1902 to 1984, is a prime example of the resort town's spa architecture

Re-opened in summer 2006, today it is home to three separate facilities: an 800-sq m cultural centre with museum-quality exhibition spaces; a media library; and a new, 2,200-sq m convention centre including a 383-seat auditorium and eight meeting rooms. The newly-renamed Palace of Light is bound to play a major part in Evian's cultural life and tourist economy. It is also an outstanding example of the adaptive re-use of a historic landmark, whose main features include a high-quality restoration of the dome, interior windows and majestic hall of honour graced with stained-glass windows, statues and fountains.







Evian's 950 hotel rooms, including 450 in four-star hotels, and meeting rooms ranging in size from 20 to 1,200 seats, make it an international convention town.




