#### Jungfrauoch (Top of Europe)

With an altitude of 11,782 feet (3571 m), the Jungfrauoch trip is known as 'Top of Europe'. Once you have reached the summit, you can visit the Ice Palace or warm yourself with a hot drink in the restaurant. If you are not afraid of heights, why not take a picture with the mountains behind you and the clouds below.

#### Schilthorn (007 Heaven)

The Schilthorn is the longest aerial cableway in the Alps and takes you as high as 9744 feet (2970 m). Why not have a meal in the 360° revolving restaurant and discover over 200 mountain peaks including the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau, as well as the Bernese Alps to Mont Blanc, and as far as the Black Forest in Germany.

#### Gornergrat (The Toblerone Mountain)

With an altitude of 10135 feet (3089 m), Zermatt- Gornergrat excursion is the highest altitude open-air cogwheel railway in Europe. At the top, you cannot miss the Matterhorn, one of Switzerland's most popular landmarks.

#### **Titlis Rotair**

At 10,000 feet (3092 M), Titlis is the highest glacier excursion in Central Switzerland. It is the first revolving cable-car that takes you into a unique glacier world.

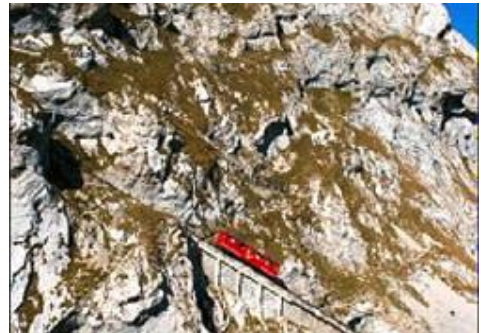
#### **Mount Pilatus (The Dragon Mountain)**

Mount Pilatus with a 48% gradient is the steepest cogwheel railway in the world, and also has 2 aerial cableways. At 7000 feet (2123 M), there are wonderful panoramic views with 73 mountain peaks to be seen including the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau as well as Titlis and the Bernese Alps.

#### **Mount Rigi (Queen of the Mountains)**

There are 3 ways to travel to Rigi Kulm situated at an altitude of 5905 feet (1800 m). Cogwheel train from Vitznau (Europe's first ever mountain railway established in 1871), cogwheel train from Goldau or cableway from Weggis.

#### **Brienzer Rothorn**

For all steam train enthusiasts, the Brienzer Rothorn is an excursion not to be missed. The steam locomotives climb to the Brienzer Rothorn (2350 M), with stunning views at the top. **In June, pay a one way fare and return for free!**

### **Männlichen**

Grindelwald-Männlichen Gondola Cableway (GGM) is 6.2 km, the longest gondola cableway in Europe. The Männlichen is in the heart of the Bernese Oberland where there are magnificent views of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau.

### **Schynige Platte**

The Schynige Platte railway climbs 4659 feet (1420 m) on its journey from Wilderswil up to Schynige Platte, famous as one of the best vantage points in the whole region.
